If applicable, the Council may consider direct or cumulative impacts not within the area of jurisdiction of another regulatory agency in this state. "Cumulative impacts" are defined as the combined impacts upon the environment Enacted West 1975 or the social or economic conditions resulting from construction and operation of the proposed industrial facility and from construction and operation of other ongoing or proposed developments in the area of site influence.
